OLD-GROWTH FOREST

...the 500-year project

ast forests once covered southern Ontario in a tapestry of pine, maple, beech, cedar and ash. Today, more than 99% of that old growth has been cleared for settlement, agriculture, and industrial development. The **Ignatius Old-Growth** Forest, the 500-year project, is fostering the restoration of a forest on the grounds of the Centre.

Walking trails can also be found within the Old-Growth Forest lands. They weave through mixed forests of white pine, hemlock, cherry, ash and maple, and through evergreen plantations and cedar groves. Lined with cedars, sections of trails follow the banks of the Speed River, while other sections open up into meadows that have been planted with native trees and shrubs as part of the restoration work of the Ignatius Old-Growth Forest project. The trails include:

- Holzer, SJ Trail
- James (Jim) Profit, SJ Trail
- Old Villa by the Speed Trail
- The Creation Trail
